- 9. If you miss each lecture session, the score for midterm control is reduced by 1 point, if you miss each session of the IWST, the score for the IWS is reduced by 2 points.
- 10. When calculating the final rating, penalty points for missed lectures and IWS's are deducted from points for foreign control.

Penalties: For missing one lecture without a valid reason, the penalty point is 1 point (lecture absences in the form of penalty points are subtracted from the midterm assessment grades (absences of IWS classes in the form of penalty points are subtracted from IWS grades). The penalty point for missing 1 IWS class is 2 points. For being late, behaving inappropriately during class, damaging department property, using a cell phone during class, 0.5 points are deducted. For late defense of IWS, 20% is deducted, in case of passing IWS during MC weeks, 50% is deducted. Incentive measures: For active participation in the educational process (participation in Olympiads, research papers, conferences), 0.5 points are added to the midterm assessment for the discipline.
