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Situational tasks of 2 midterm control

Task 1.

A 19-year-old girl was raped in a small village. The victim did not inform anyone about the sexual violence, except for her parents and the doctor. She turned to the doctor, having a pregnancy of 6 weeks with a request to have an abortion at home in order to avoid publicity. The doctor refused her. The victim became depressed and committed suicide. The parents accused the doctor of driving him to suicide, and when the doctor in the course of his interrogation reported the details of the circumstances, the law enforcement authorities – in disclosing medical secrets.

Question: Is the doctor right from a legal point of view when he refused the girl an abortion and when he "reported the details" during the interrogation?

Task 2.

A young man, a Chechen by nationality, and a Russian police major were simultaneously taken to a small hospital, who injured each other in a criminal situation. The general condition of the victims was about the same. Russian doctors by nationality provided full-fledged medical assistance to the police major and actually refused to provide full-fledged assistance to the young man without valid reasons, limiting themselves only to stopping external bleeding. Failure to provide medical assistance to the victim led to the development of a life-threatening condition. **Question:** Is there a violation of ethical principles in the actions of doctors? Explain.

Task 3.

Ivanova, who is registered in a narcological dispensary, received a call for examination for the second time. However, she did not appear on the call. Task 4.

During the fluorographic examination and subsequent diagnosis, the director of school No. 1 Petrenko I.V. was diagnosed with tuberculosis. The chief doctor of the polyclinic sent a message to the head of the Department of Education about this fact. The director of the school filed a complaint about the disclosure of medical secrets.

Question: Is the complaint justified?

Task 5.

N. Sergacheva, 14 years old, turned to the dermatology dispensary, where she was diagnosed with trichomoniasis. The doctor asked for information about the parents, intending to give them this information. Sergacheva was indignant and reminded him of medical secrecy.

Question: Who is right?

Task 6.

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Litvinov addressed the Emergency medical hospitals about a gunshot wound to the leg, explaining that he caused the injury himself due to careless handling of weapons. The doctor on duty reported information about the fact of Litvinov's appeal to the police station on duty. After 10 days, the bodies of inquiry refused to initiate a criminal case due to the absence of a crime event. Litvinov complained about the actions of the doctor on duty upon the disclosure of medical secrets.

Question: What would be your response to Litvinov's complaint?

Task 7.

The dermatologist Samoilova, while visiting a friend of Feoktistova, advised her not to allow her daughter to play with a neighbor girl, Lindova, because she was at a reception with Samoilova, and the girl was found to have scabies. Lindova is a famous massage therapist. Feoktistova was visited by 2 clients of the masseur Lindova, who refused her sessions the next day, explaining this by the contagious illness of her daughter.

Question: Are there any violations of the patient's rights in this situation?

Task 8.

Patient M., 15 years old, was taken from the summer camp by ambulance to the emergency department of the district hospital with a diagnosis of acute enterocolitis. Ill for four days. An appendicular abscess was diagnosed in the emergency department, and the girl was operated on urgently. The girl's consent to the operation was obtained. The girl's father, who arrived 3 hours later, filed a complaint against the actions of the surgeon on duty, since the operation was performed without the consent of the parents of a person who had not reached the age of majority.

Question: Are the claims of the girl's father fair?

Task 9.

Patient K., 43 years old, was being treated at the general surgery clinic of the Medical Academy with a diagnosis of acute hemorrhoidal thrombosis. Conservative therapy was carried out. The patient himself suspected liver disease, about which he studied the relevant medical literature. I didn't tell the doctors about it during the conversation, because I was embarrassed to admit to regular alcohol consumption. He asked the attending physician to show him a biochemical blood test, which he was refused. During the study examination, the student showed the patient a biochemical analysis, where there was a slight increase in alanine aminotransferase and aspartate aminotransferase, after which the patient asked the attending physician to invite a hepatologist for a consultation. Instead, the doctor prescribed an ultrasound of the liver, in which no changes were found at that time, and after the acute hemorrhoids subsided, the patient was discharged with a recommendation to operate as planned. After 6 months, this patient was admitted to the city hospital with a detailed picture of cirrhosis of the liver.

Question: Please indicate what mistakes the clinic doctor made from a legal point of view?

Task 10.

Klinchenko, suffering from bronchial asthma, due to an attack of suffocation, causedsmall business entities. The small business entities team offered Klinchenko an injection. Klinchenko agreed. After the small business entities team left, he had an unusual reaction to the medicine.

Klinchenko suspected that this medicine gave an allergic reaction, but he did not know its name due to the fact that he was not informed about the treatment being carried out, and also did not find out the possibility of an allergic reaction.

Question: What rights of Klinchenko's patient have been violated?

Task 11.

The patient F. was tested for venereal disease, which showed the presence of gonorrhea in F.. At the reception, the gynecologist said that F. F. cried and said that she was afraid to tell him about it, to which the doctor grossly insulted F.

Question: What right of the patient is violated?

Task 12.

After the examination, the 16-year-old patient M. asked the attending physician what her diagnosis was. The doctor called the diagnosis "Emphysema of the lungs". The patient asked to explain in more detail. The doctor replied that he did not have time for this, but you can read in detail in the medical encyclopedia, and in general, he intends to talk about M.'s illness with her parents, not with her.

Question: What rights of the patient have been violated?

Task 13.

A child, 1 year old, died during the operation. Parents require copies of medical documents to apply to the court. The hospital refused to issue, explaining that copies of medical documents are issued only at the written request of the court.

Question: Explain to parents their rights in this situation.
